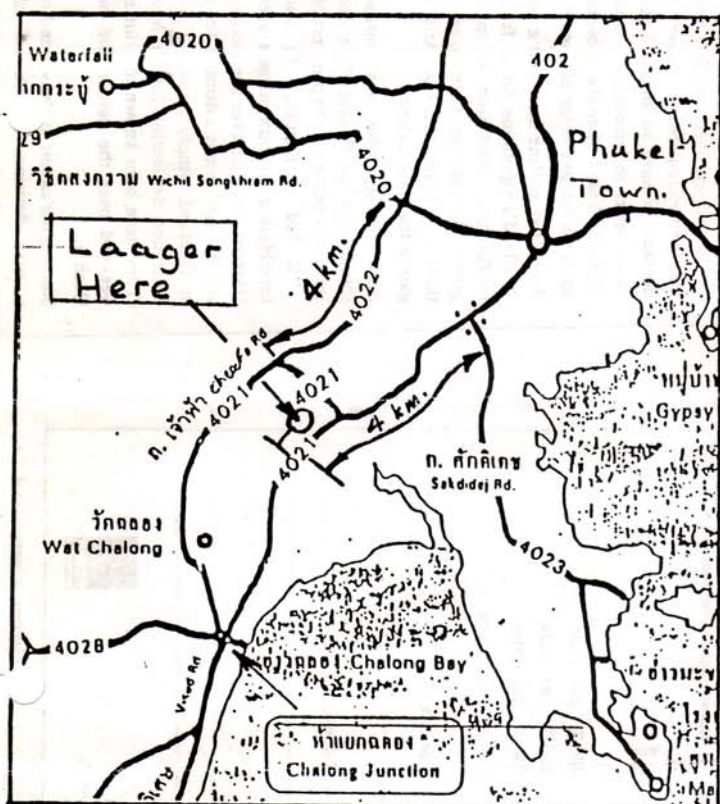

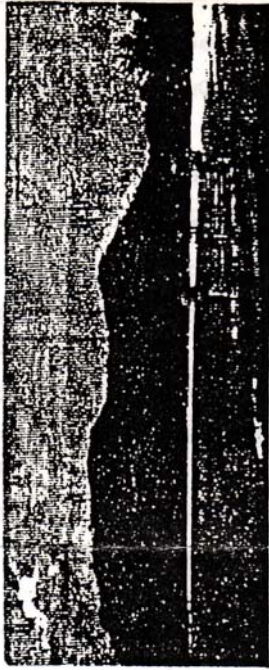

Rule 9. A trail should be about 6 kilometres in length taking about 50 minutes to run. Runs of insufficient length will be awarded a Hashit. Try and put a little variety into your run; a little shiggy, a river, a few hills, open country, orchard, bridges, water holes etc. More than 500 m tarmac could be a hashit.

HashAsia '87

Phuket Island venue fixed



Relax Bay Resort on the west coast of southern Thailand's magnificent Phuket Island, has been selected as the venue for HashAsia '87, to be held in mid-August next year. This new bi-annual event has been introduced in answer to the very heavy demand to have an annual Thailand meet. And when better to introduce it, than in "1987-Visit Thailand Year" when the whole country is gearing up for a massive surge of incoming visitors. Promoted as "the most exotic country in Asia", Thailand's reputation for its famed hospitality is irrefutable. And with so many Hashers not getting the opportunity to make an InterHash for time or leave reasons, HashAsia will fill the clear gap in the Hash calendar.

Alan Cooke, who was instrumental in the founding of the Phuket Hash House Harriers, is extremely excited at the prospect of HashAsia '87. "It had to happen," he said. "The main InterHash event now attracts over two thousand Hashers from all over the world and is a grand affair. But there is a demand for an event to stay in Thailand, simply because it is a very popular outstation destination for the Malaysian clubs." (They have been known to print special T-shirts, weekend over the border and not even run a Hash!).

Andaman Sea is one of the newest world resorts. Daily flights from the surrounding Asian capitals to the international airport just minutes from the quiet sandy beaches, will speed its popularity. Hashing hills, fields, paddies, jungle and plantations, a guaranteed event is assured.

InterHash '86 had one thousand Hashers who did not attend for one reason or another. Positioned later in the summer, it is hoped to provide Asia's Hashers with an alternative event in great surroundings. And clearly, staging it in Thailand is a sure formula for success!

The key to organising successful ongoing events is to ensure good value for money, whilst keeping registration fees to a reasonable level. Being a smaller event than the "big one", it will still attract sponsorship, without which costs escalate. Hashers are no different to any other group who meet internationally. They know what they want. If they are not competing with three thousand others for a bus, a beer, a pie or a poke, they will come. HashAsia '87 appears set to provide just what Hashers want. A fun time in the true Hash tradition, without the Hash Hoardes. And by being a smaller regular event, it will positively benefit the future InterHash organisers, who may not feel like organising numbers over five thousand in the next decade.

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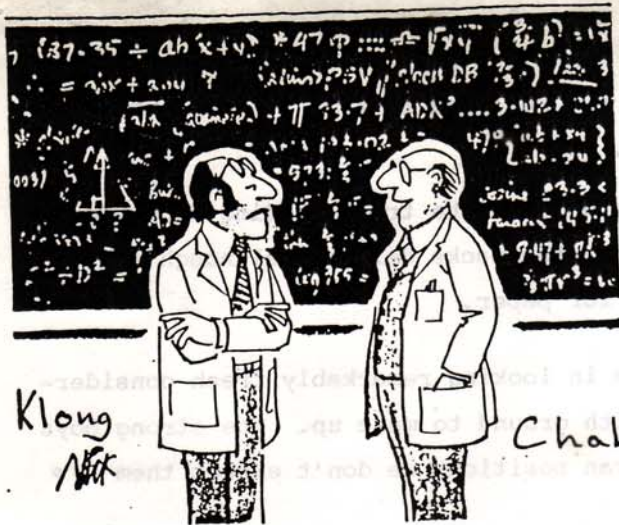

RUN NO. 10 REPORT

Saturday: 23rd August 1986

Time : 5:10 p.m.

The weather turned out to be hot which ensured a good turnout. We hosted three runners from the Selctar Hash in Singapore two of which, Janita and James were on their honeymoon. We were surprised to see them finish with the pack, expecting them to disappear on one of the false trails and reappear only when the Kloster had run out.

Shortly after the run began the first check took the front runners on a slight detour, backtracking found the pack in the lead and fortunately the run at this stage was in Indian file order which slowed down the power boys a little, although with a bit of bashing through trees and undergrowth they managed to pass most of the pack. Gunter and Noi were well in contention as was Wim, who seemed to blow a gasket a little later, obviously suffering from the activities of the night before.

There followed some twists and turns through the jungle with a few fallen logs to stumble over until the trail led us uphill through a pineapple plantation and at this stage Hennes's son was going well, no sign of his dad though, maybe he'd been out with Wim.

Jim and Brain were in their accustomed place again but the Horn, Alan, was in touch and keeping the rest of the pack in close attendance. There was then a sharp trip downhill which found a number of hashers lacking in brake power but somehow managed to get to the bottom without any major mishaps. We imagine that one accident did happen, Ann split her leopard skin tights and had to retreat at the end of the run to procure a replacement.

Okuoka was steadily gaining at this time only to find a false going uphill again and the runner were checking for some time at the roadway. - " กระดาษ " ทางที่โรย ด้วยกระดาษโดย "กระดาษป่า" นี้คือทางที่คุณจะต้องวิ่งตาม
- " On On " เวลาที่วิ่งตามกระดาษ คุณต้องร้อง "On On" เพื่อประกาศว่าคุณกำลังวิ่งอยู่บนกระดาษ และเพื่อให้ "สุนัขล่ากระดาษ" อื่น ๆ รู้ เพื่อที่จะได้ติดตามคุณ
- " Are you on " การร้องถามเพื่อต้องการที่จะรู้ว่า มีใครบ้างที่กำลังวิ่งอยู่บนกระดาษ คำตอบอาจจะเป็น "Checking" หรือ "On On" แล้วแต่สถานการณ์
- " Check Back " ถ้ากระดาษหายออกไปเฉย ๆ ผู้ที่วิ่งอยู่ข้างหน้า จะร้อง " Check Back " เพื่อให้ผู้ติดตามหลังช่วยกันค้นหากระดาษ กระดาษนี้อาจจะอยู่ในทิศทางไหนก็ได้ ฉะนั้น "สุนัขล่ากระดาษ" ทั้งหลายจึงควรกระจายกันออกหาเมื่อไรพบกระดาษสำหรับทางใหม่ ให้ร้อง " On On "
- " Checking " คำตอบสำหรับบอกว่า "กำลังหาร่องรอยของกระดาษอยู่" ใช้ตอบสำหรับคำถาม " Are you on "
- " Hash Horn " แตรสำหรับใช้ส่งเสียงบอกสัญญาณเพื่อให้ "สุนัขล่ากระดาษ" ทั้งหลายทราบว่า เขากอนนั้นกำลังวิ่งตามกระดาษอยู่ และให้ทุกคนติดตามปกติ ผู้ถือแตร ควรเป็นนักวิ่งที่ดี
- " แปลงเพาะปลูก " อย่าวิ่งข้ามแปลงเพาะปลูก หรือวิ่งบนคันนาเล็ก ๆ วิ่งเฉาะบนพื้นที่แน่นและแข็งแรง
